Working with Slope

Expanded metal fence easily adapts to multiple ground sloping situations. Although the fence cannot be raked due to the inherent rigidity of the expanded metal, we recommend stair stepping the panels to accommodate the grade of the slope.

Depending on your drop off, and the amount of gap that is acceptable for your project, the installation is best accomplished by decreasing the post spacing until the projected gap reaches a reasonable opening at the lower edge.

Alternatively- you can choose to bury the mesh at the bottom of the run or cut to 1" above grade before install.

GRADIENT	MEASUREMENT	POSSIBLE GAP
gradual	1 in 20	0-5 inches over 8ft span
gradual	1 in 10	0-10 inches over 8ft span
steep	1 in 9+	0-20 inches over 8ft span

For steep slope areas, you will need to order longer posts and possibly request custom cut panels to ensure your final project has continuity with the fence line.
